## Budget

## Tasks to prepare the Belgian exchange

- Prepare an online English survey
  - o We asks the questions
    - 100-150 pupils

- Aged 14-17
- The pupils prepare some questions for the mayor of Kasterlee
- The pupils do research on how to give a speech about a topic
- The pupils search for the speeches and then the students answer these questions
  - Political speech: in order to convince someone
  - Inauguration
  - Presentation about a certain topic: informative speech

### Questions to be answered in a presentation

- What kind of speech is this?
- The way it is given, is it in accordance with the topic? Is it appropriate?
- Is it communicative, is it effective?
- What is the aim of this speech?
- What kind of words does the person use?
- What is the audience?
- Are the previously mentioned items good for his type of audience?
- Does the speaker focus on emotions?
- How did they do it? (body language, intonation...)
- What are the strategies?

## Steps in Belgium

Step 1: Presentations about the speech they watched + results survey: **Belgium**

Step 2: Prepare tutorial: **Germany**

Step 3: More than a speech: Workshop body language, quality of a speech: lively workshop, e.g. mime it, then just using the voice, then putting it together: **Italy** will be responsible

Step 3: Prepare a speech: **Romania** will think about the topics

➔ 12 pupils in each group

➔ 9 topics

- We prepare some more so they can all take something they want

## Tasks to prepare the German exchange

Focus: why do we speak?

We want you to focus on this topic (populism). Speeches can also be used to influence people.

- Each country does some research on one European hot topic (e.g. populism), a topic which will be in the focus the whole week. Every group is responsible for one media channel
  - The groups inform themselves and prepare a presentation about populism in their home countries.
    - o Television, newspaper and Internet
    - o Answer the following questions
    - o Fill out the table
    - o Prepare the presentation
- ➔ Different missions (3 groups of every country: two who do the actual exchange and four others)

Guided questions: I have a word to say

1. What is populism? Explain the main characteristics. In which contexts can it be found? Which subjects are inflicted.
2. Do you think populism is present in your country? Look for examples in your own country. (analyse also the language and the body language) Present the political/social situation in your country/hometown.
3. Find three examples on television/three on social media/three on newspaper where the characteristics discovered in the definition of populism can be found.

Prepare a presentation of at least 10 minutes. Explain why your examples contain populism/which characteristics can be found in it (link to the definition).

- Make a **presentation** (at least 10 minutes) about these matters for the other countries.
  - o You prepare a presentation on the political system together, then two present what they found of social media, two tell about television and two about newspaper.

**Belgium:** brings information on text structures and how to write it for the written report for the student's magazine.
